1. Written Exam

Total marks of written examination shall be divided into two parts comprising:-

- 75% weightage for **General Awareness, Reasoning, Maths, Science, Computer, English, Hindi and concerned or relevant subject, as applicable.**
- 25% weightage for **History, Current Affairs, Literature, Geography, Civics, Environment, Culture etc. of Haryana.**

2. Socio-Economic criteria and experience

The marks for socio-economic criteria and experience shall be allocated as follows:

- if neither the applicant nor any person from among the applicant's family viz father, mother, spouse, brother, and Son is, was or has been a regular employee in any Department/Board/

Corporation/Company/StatutoryBody/Commission/Authority of Government of Haryana or any other State Government or Government of India

(5 marks)

•if the applicant is:-

- a widow; or
- The first or the second child and his father had died before attaining the age of 42 years: or
- The first or the second child and his father had died before the applicant had attained the age of 15 years,“.

(5 marks)

•If the applicant belongs to such a denotified tribe (Vimukt Jatis and Tapriwas Jatis) or Nomadic tribe of the State of Haryana which is neither a Scheduled Caste nor a Backward Class. **(5 marks)**

•Experience: One-half(=0.5) mark for each year or part thereof exceeding six month of experience, out of a maximum of sixteen years, on the same or a higher post in any Department/Board/Corporation/Company/Statutory Body/Commission/Authority of Government of Haryana. No marks shall be awarded for any period less than six months. **(A maximum of 8 marks)**

Note:- No applicant shall be given more than 10 marks for socio economic criteria and experience under any circumstances.
